ELA

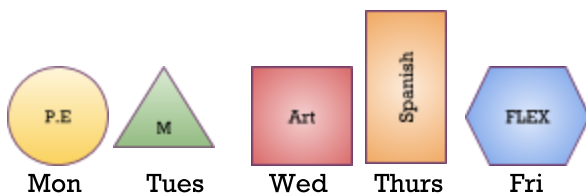
- Begin studying a new author
